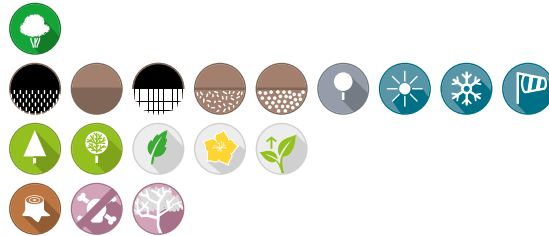


Pinus mugo subsp. uncinata



Height	20-25 m
Crown	pyramidal to broad oval, dark, dense crown
Bark and branches	grey, black flaking
Leaf	green, evergreen
Flowers	light yellow may
Fruits	brown
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	all
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	3 (-40,0 to -24,5 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind
Application	parks, cemeteries, coastal areas, industrial areas, large gardens
Shape	multi-stem treem
