

Prunus cerasus 'Rhexii'



Height	3-5 m
Crown	round/spherical, dark, dense crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	brown
Leaf	green
Flowers	white, double, flowers in May
Fruits	fruitless cultivar
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	fairly
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens
