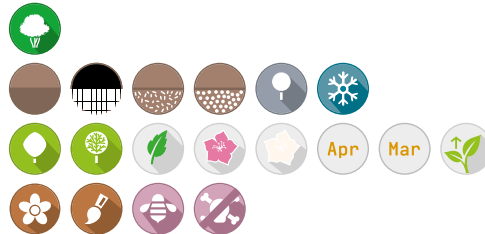




## Prunus incisa 'Oshidori'



Height	3-5 m
Crown	broad vase-shaped, dark, dense crown
Bark and branches	brown, grey
Leaf	green
Autumn colour	orange, red
Flowers	pinkish white, flowers in March-April
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	all
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	6b (-20,5 to -17,8 °C)
Wind resistance	moderate
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	parks, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens, patio gardens
Shape	multi-stem treem
