



## Quercus affinis



<b>Height</b>	10 – 15 (30) m
<b>Crown</b>	narrow oval
<b>Bark and branches</b>	branches reddish brown: bark dark green-grey, finely grooved and checkered
<b>Leaf</b>	oblong to lanceolate, 3-10 cm, glossy dark green, evergreen
<b>Flowers</b>	catkins, inconspicuous
<b>Fruits</b>	almost round acorn, 1-1.5 cm long
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	8 (-12,2 to -6,7 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	good
<b>Other resistances</b>	can withstand wind
<b>Application</b>	avenues and broad streets, parks, cemeteries, large gardens
<b>Origin</b>	North Africa
