

Quercus affinis



Height	10 – 15 (30) m
Crown	narrow oval
Bark and branches	branches reddish brown: bark dark green-grey, finely grooved and checkered
Leaf	oblong to lanceolate, 3-10 cm, glossy dark green, evergreen
Flowers	catkins, inconspicuous
Fruits	almost round acorn, 1-1.5 cm long
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	8 (-12,2 to -6,7 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	can withstand wind
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, cemeteries, large gardens
