



Quercus alba 'Clara'



Height	20-30 m
Crown	broad round crown
Bark and branches	light grey-brown bark, deeply grooved
Leaf	lobed, elongated to obovate, dark green/blue green
Autumn colour	red
Flowers	Catkins, yellow/green, flowers in May
Fruits	elongated-oval acorn
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	good
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), can withstand wind, resistant to de-icing salt
Application	avenues and broad streets, parks, cemeteries, large gardens
Shape	clearstem tree
