Robinia ×margaretta 'Georgia da Torino'



Height	6-10 m, fast growing
Crown	round, half-open crown, capricious growing
Bark and branches	almost thornless
Leaf	bright green, feathered
Autumn colour	yellow
Flowers	deep pink to pink-red, flowers in May-June
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Soil moisture	suitable for dry soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5 (-28,8 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	fairly
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for bees (honey plant)
Application	parks, cemeteries, industrial areas, large gardens
