



## Staphylea pinnata



<b>Height</b>	2-5 m
<b>Crown</b>	oval, later vase-shaped, half open crown
<b>Bark and branches</b>	brown
<b>Leaf</b>	green
<b>Flowers</b>	creamy white to greenish white, flowers in May-June, fragrant flowers
<b>Fruits</b>	yellow brown
<b>Spines/thorns</b>	None
<b>Toxicity</b>	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
<b>Soil type</b>	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
<b>Paving</b>	tolerates no paving
<b>Winter hardiness zone</b>	5b (-26,0 to -23,4 °C)
<b>Wind resistance</b>	fairly
<b>Other resistances</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
<b>Fauna tree</b>	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
<b>Application</b>	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens
<b>Shape</b>	multi-stem treem
<b>Origin</b>	Central and Southern Europe, Asia Minor
