

Staphylea pinnata



Height	2-5 m
Crown	oval, later vase-shaped, half open crown
Bark and branches	brown
Leaf	green
Flowers	creamy white to greenish white, flowers in May-June, fragrant flowers
Fruits	yellow brown
Spines/thorns	None
Toxicity	usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock
Soil type	clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil
Paving	tolerates no paving
Winter hardiness zone	5b (-26,0 to -23,4 °C)
Wind resistance	fairly
Other resistances	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6)
Fauna tree	resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies
Application	parks, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens
Shape	multi-stem treem
Origin	Central and Southern Europe, Asia Minor
