| Height | 2-5 m |
| Crown | oval, later vase-shaped, half open crown |
| Bark and branches | brown |
| Leaf | green |
| Flowers | creamy white to greenish white, flowers in May, fragrant flowers |
| Fruits | yellow brown |
| Spines/thorns | None |
| Toxicity | usually not toxic to people, (large) pets and livestock |
| Soil type | clayed soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, calcareous soil |
| Paving | tolerates no paving |
| Winter hardiness zone | 5b (-26,0 to -23,4 °C) |
| Wind resistance | fairly |
| Other resistances | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6) |
| Fauna tree | resistant to frost (WH 1 - 6), valuable for butterflies |
| Application | parks, tree containers, cemeteries, large gardens, small gardens |
| Origin | Eastern North America |
